

# Abbreviated List of FSA Eligible Expenses

- Acupuncture
- Alcoholism Treatment
- Birth Control Pills
- Contact Lenses & Insurance
- Diagnostic Fees
- Diets, prescribed (Costs above normal meals)
- Disabled Care for physically & mentally handicapped. Examples:
  - Special Education (including boarding)
  - Hearing Devices and Batteries
  - Telephone/Television Equipment for Deaf
  - Braille Books and Magazines
  - Guide for Blind
  - Dyslexia (Language/Remedial Training)
  - Car Controls for Handicapped
  - Artificial Limbs, Crutches
  - Note-Taker (Deaf College Student)
  - Seeing Eye Dog
- Doctors & Practitioners Fees. Examples:
  - Physicians
  - Psychologists
  - Dentists
  - Optometrists
  - Osteopaths
  - Christian Science Practitioners
  - Nurses (Private Duty)
  - Physical Therapists
  - Chiropractors
  - Anesthetists
  - Midwife
- Drug Abuse Treatment
- Eye Surgery (including vision correction)
- Fertility Treatments; Sterilization Fees
- Halfway House (Psychiatrist recommended)
- Hospital Bills
- Hypnosis to Treat Illness
- Insurance Deductibles & Co-Payments
- Laboratory Fees
- Medical Equipment. Examples:
  - Bandaging Supplies
  - Elastic Stockings
  - Hospital Bed
  - Home Improvements
  - Swimming Pool / Spa
  - Oxygen & Equipment
  - Disposable Diapers -- (non-infant)
  - Wigs
  - Walkers and Wheelchairs
  - Orthopedic Shoes
- Organ Donor Costs
- Physical Exams (Routine)
- Prescription Drugs
- Smoking Cessation Programs (prescribed)
- Sex Therapy (psychiatrist)
- Transportation & Lodging for Medical Care (limited)

**Note:** Over-the-counter drugs & medicines are no longer eligible without a written prescription.
